As we celebrate our ten year anniversary of the inception of NSAA, we realize now, more than ever, the road we have traveled to reach our dreams.

We recall the path we took to get where we are right now...a small space we rented at the lower level of the Grafton mill, with a hand built stage ten inches off the ground, and the yellow brick road painted down the driveway.

Our first musical had 20 kids and one director and one show. We now have over 130 children participating in one production, with a run of 11 shows and a crew of over twenty.

We've moved to a grand building, we've grown our art department to include a kiln and potters wheel, we've developed a literary arts department and worked with the nationally renowned Highlights Magazine, we've built a dance studio with nine dance classes running and dance teams participating in nationals. We have fostered a preschool in the arts experience for our wee ones, the time in a child's life where it all begins...

And so we celebrate - the beginning of the next decade of success for NSAA, today, with the power of team work. Together, we will build so that others can live a full life enriched through the arts... and beyond.

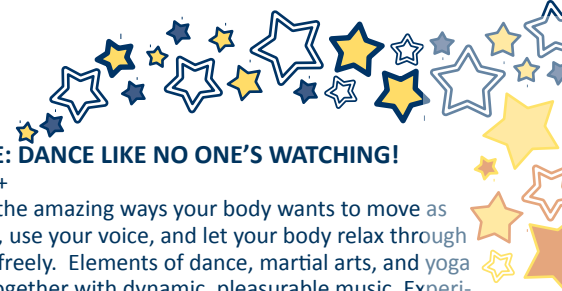
